The Holy Spirit alone.



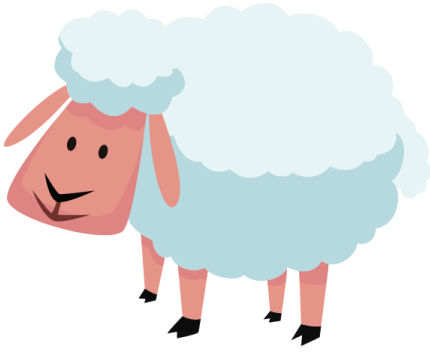
