5. Can anyone be saved through the covenant of works?

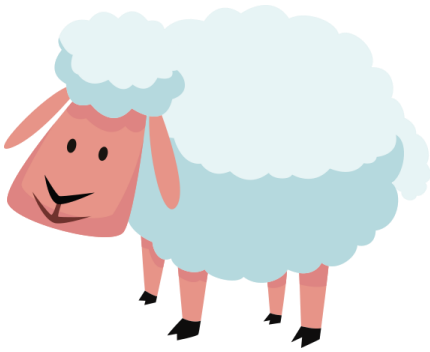
None can be saved through the covenant of works.
